

## Group **Quick** Start Guide

Study The AA Group pamphlet.

**Gain** support from other AA members in or near your community. Attend AA meetings and let members know you intend to start a new group.

Find a meeting place; determine the day(s) and time of the meeting.

**Develop** your meeting format. Remember you can change it as you find what works and what doesn't.

**Review** the Local Central Office website for lots of support materials; including sample meeting formats; aalakesumter.org

**Contact** your Central Office (352-360-0960) to announce your new group. The Central Office usually oversees:

**Register** and update your group's meeting information with AA World Service. (See aalakesumter.org for form).
