Anthony House is a residential facility serving intact families, single females and substance misusing pregnant and postpartum women. This is NOT a homeless shelter; it is a transitional housing facility.

They provide interim housing, wraparound services and rapid re-housing principles that help to address the myriad issues, determinants and institutions that contribute to homelessness. Wraparound services refer to a comprehensive service provision model that guarantees that any of the services needed by an individual or family are integrated through a cohesive individualized services plan that guises all services. Anthony House will provide offices on-site for other community agencies to deliver services to the residents. Agencies will work together to develop a plan of action for each family focusing on health care, employment services, education services, education, mental health and substance abuse, child care and transportation services.

#### Children's Outpatient Mental Health Services

Individual, family, group and peer therapy is provided for children ages 4-18. Individualized treatment plans address behavioral issues, depression, anxiety, family conflict, trauma/abuse, and self-esteem.

#### Children's Substance Abuse Outpatient Services

Outpatient group and individual therapeutic intervention is provided, after a comprehensive intake, treatment plan development, and three sessions in a Triage group. In the Triage group clients are provided with psychoeducation on substance abuse and dependence, reframing and restructuring skills, and information to acclimate them to the therapeutic process. All treatment plans are individualized to provide the best possible outcomes for recovery.

#### Mental Health Targeted Case Management

Case management services consist of activities aimed at assessing recipient needs, planning services, linking the service system to a recipient, coordinating the various system components, monitoring service delivery and evaluating the effect of services received. These services are typically offered to persons who are being discharged from a hospital or crisis stabilization unit, who are in need of more professional care, and who will have contingency needs to remain in a less restrictive setting

### Charlotte County Medication Assisted Patient Services (MAPS)

Our Charlotte County MAPS program provides all FDA approved medications for opiate addiction including methadone, buprenorphine, and long-acting naltrexone (Vivitrol), Methadone maintenance, counseling, and medical services. HIV risk assessment to opiate-addicted clients is also provided.

All patients who qualify for treatment receive the following:

- Physical Examination and Laboratory Workup
- In-depth Assessment of their Life Systems (Biopsychosocial Assessment)
- Individualized Treatment Plan
- Regular Counseling by Trained Staff
- Specialized Treatment for Pregnant Women
- HIV/AIDS services

All our treatment centers are CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) accredited. CARF is an independent, nonprofit accreditor of health and human services which evaluates treatment and rehabilitation centers to make sure they offer safe and high-quality care.
