It is an office established to perform functions common to all AA groups and our purpose is to aid groups in carrying their message to alcoholics who still suffer.

If you would like your group's voice to be heard, you may elect a representative to attend our monthly business meeting on the second Wednesday of each month at 6:30 pm. Your elected Lake-Sumter Central Office (LSCO) representative will then have the opportunity to vote on all Central Office topics brought forward during the monthly business meeting.

Your group representative may then share with their group the topics discussed and the highlights of the monthly Central Office meeting.

THE ROLE OF THE Intergroup Rep The IGR is elected by their group. They then attend the monthly intergroup business meetings (2nd Wednesday of each month at 6:30 pm). To this meeting you bring any suggestions, comments or opinions your group may have. The IGR or alternate casts their group's vote on all matters requiring a group conscience and represents their home group in all matters concerning Lake-Sumter Central Office (LSCO). You are the point of contact for LSCO should it wish to communicate in any way with your home group and are the conduit for any information, concerns, ideas and anything that your home group may want to send to the LSCO.

WHAT DOES CENTRAL OFFICE DO FOR YOU?

Maintains an open AA service office Monday—Friday 10-2

Provides a 24 hour hotline consisting of volunteer alcoholics during and after hours and on holidays and weekends.

Provides a wide selection of AA literature, pamphlets and merchandise for sale to groups and individuals. Both conference and non-conference approved literature are available.

Maintains online Meeting Chair App.

Makes available LSCO "Where & When" meeting schedules and information about other AA community events.

Publishes the monthly "Serenity News" newsletter.

Serves as a repository for the collection of "pink can" donations which are used to purchase AA literature that is distributed to local jail/prison inmates.

LSCO provides various opportunities for volunteers to be of service in helping our groups carry the message of Alcoholics Anonymous.
