2. **Key Leader Jim V: TAVARES MALE FRIDAYS- 6:15-9PM- 3 PODS X 2 (2 hours).** *No volunteers needed at this time. **79 Males attended this month.** Still having problems with parking yet no problems with entry into Detention Center and conducting meetings.
