TREASURER REPORT: Beginning balance was \$16,440 and ending balance was \$14,898. Total income was 7,503.90 with expenses being 9,447.60. Report was put to audit as is.

OLD BUSINESS: We had the Workshop (steps 10,11,12) and took in \$57. Expenses were for rent of \$125. October 16th is open house from 10-2 p.m. which sandwiches and fruit will be served. Events committee is still looking for a guest speaker for the Christmas Gala. No tickets will be sold at the door. We will be having a DJ this year. It was brought up again to try to use Zelle or Venmo which will be further investigated. Kelly H. from Clermont stood for secretary and the vote was unanimous. Jim L., the Serenity Newsletter Editor is asking for contributions from the AA community. He said to send all information to aalakesumter@gmail.com or bring to office. Thursdays we are looking for someone to sit at front desk and answer the phone. Minimum of one year is necessary. Rhond H. made a list of literature prices with Amazon vs. LSCO.
