We are doing this to get an accurate count for the food and tables. We do have a speaker for the Gala, David J. We had the Open House and had a great turn out about 40 people showed up. We are having a workshop on Drop the Rock; The Ripple Effect March 29th and the Unity Picnic will be March 14th.

Hotline: Tom is switching up Hotline volunteers and needs more people to feel this slots. Must have one year of sobriety and do a 1 day a week 12-hour shift.

Corrections: Lisa in corrections says they had 266 inmates (they are so willing in jail). Please help corrections by talking about the pink cans and placing them inside the donation basket. Sumter women need 2 years of Sobriety to go to the jails. They have a new literature leader Paul K. Patty is the pink can Chair. The month donations were \$1353, and YTD \$10,460 and the

expenses were \$804 and YTD \$14,871 with a balance of \$3245.96. Eighteen groups donated.
