The meeting was opened by Rhonda followed by a moment of silence, followed by the Serenity Prayer. There were 17 attendees.

Secretary Report: Chris read the report from March and it was approved with amendment to correct math error.

Treasurer's Report: Andy read the report as follows: Checking account balance \$11,784.03 and a Prudent Reserve of \$30,001.11 with total available funds \$40,103.08. Income of \$5,878.85 (donations \$3,329.33, merchandise \$1,868.27, events \$563.28), expenses of \$5,760.55 (payroll \$1,964.84, rental \$1,277.49, website hosting \$1,060.36 includes annual fees).

New Business: Founders Day planning June 9, 5-8 pm. Budget tabled until May. Confirmed 5-6 helpers, with Lori coordinating. New positions were filled including corrections chair and speaker exchange coordinator. Chuck is the new chair for the Hotline.

Office Report: Financial report Year to date shows healthy performance (\$24,145.64 income vs \$19,906.31 expenses). Audit of 4th quarter books produced a minor discrepancy of \$.29. Sobriety News Letter submitted for April, submissions welcome at Lake Sumter gmail account.

Corrections Committee Report: Lake County Jail has 6 male meetings per week, 2 female meetings per week (10+ years sobriety required). Sumter County 2+ years sobriety required. Male inmates 99 with 9 volunteers, need more volunteers, female inmates 78 with 5 volunteers, need more volunteers. Total inmates served 311.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting, it was seconded. Meeting closed with the Serenity Prayer.
