

Lake Sumter Central Office Steering Committee

August 5, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Rhonda followed by the Serenity Prayer. Attendees were Rhonda, Shannon, Thom, Andy, Jim and Chris.

Secretary Report: Chris read the July Steering Committee minutes. A motion was made to accept the minutes, all approved.

Treasurers Report: Since it was the beginning of the month Andy did not have the report completed. As of this writing it was complete and is the following: Beginning checking account balance was \$5,274.01, ending balance \$9,453.73 (a \$5,000 transfer was made from the Prudential Reserve due to cash flow), Prudential Reserve beginning balance \$30,001.85, ending balance \$25,002.07. That represents 4.5 months of Prudent Reserve versus the 6 month policy target. Monthly income \$16,159.39, expenses \$11,979.45. Year to date \$9,531 has been withdrawn from the Prudential Reserve, this is the 2nd transfer this year. Unusual expenses were the Website host, (HostGator) charged \$2,054.47 for a 3 year renewal. Andy to check to be sure beginning dates are correct. Andy will find out if there is Overdraft Protection on the checking account.

New Business: Microsoft Publisher has been discontinued, alternates to be used are Microsoft Word or Power Point. Treasurers report will be simplified for the Intergroup Reps and the Website. Prudent Reserve will be on the bottom of the page.

Office Report: There were 6 Corrections, 22 Donations, 6 Visitors, 32 Literature, 19 phone calls. Total 85. Only 32 of the 90 groups have made a donation in July to Intergroup. How to increase donations was tabled as there was no resolution.

Events: Unity picnic fee to increase to \$10 per person from \$6. It will be held at Okahumpka State Park on March 6, 2027. Price includes hamburgers and hot dogs with a request for people to bring a dish. Christmas Gala fund raiser is \$20.00 per centerpiece, donors receive recognition, person with the least sobriety will be given the centerpiece to take home.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting, it was seconded. Close of the meeting with the Serenity Prayer.
